Learned counsel for the petitioner never brought to the notice of this Court that LPA and SLP were preferred against the order, the non-compliance of which he alleges in this contempt petition. The previous order of this Court dated 22.9.2015 was passed in the presence of the learned counsel for the petitioner and it was his duty to point out that SLP was pending against this very order and not in a related case. The Court strongly deprecates this practice of concealment of facts. Since the additional affidavit indicates that SLP has been preferred against the order non-compliance of which the petitioner alleges, the instant contempt petition is dismissed leaving the parties to the outcome of the SLP.
