Main case

Compliance affidavit by Surinder Paul, Deputy Director (Grants) office of Director Public Instructions (Colleges) Punjab on behalf of respondents no.1 and 2 has been filed in the Court today and the same is taken on record. In para 5 of this affidavit it has been stated as under:-

“5. That the Govt. of Punjab vide its sanction No.

11/56/13-3 Edu. 1/609184/2-3 dated 14.10.2015 has issued the

necessary financial sanction for Rupees 27,73,838/- (Twenty seven

lac seventy three thousand eight hundred thirty eight) for the petitioner as accrued benefits. Thereafter the officer of Director Public Instructions (Colleges) Punjab has sent an online bill no.36 dated 14.10.2015 amounting to Rs.27,73,838/- to the District Treasury Officer, Punjab, Chandigarh to directly pay of the same to the employer private aided college of the petitioner i.e Patel Memorial College, Rajpura through RTGS for further disbursement of it to the petitioner. Thus, to humble understanding of the deponent the orders of this Hon'ble Court has been comply with.”

It indicates that an amount of Rs.27,73,838/- has been sent to the District Treasury for direct payment to the college for further disbursement to the petitioner.

In view of above, the present petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous but with a further direction that the official respondents shall ensure that the payment is made to the college who in turn shall also ensure that the amount is disbursed to the petitioner for satisfaction of his claim within a period of two weeks from today positively.

College – respondent no.3 has also filed a separate application (CM no. 22130-CII of 2015) indicating payment in view of 5% share obligating them to make payment to the petitioner.
