**COCP No. 504 of 2015**

Instructions have been issued by Transport Commissioner,  
Haryana, Chandigarh vide Memo No. 14682-702/T-1/ST-III on the Issue of  
time table with regard to the stage carriage permits granted under the Stage  
Carriage Scheme, 2013. The instructions reads as under:-

*“I have been directed to inform you that  
the matter regarding issue of time table with regard to  
the stage carriage permits granted under the Stage  
Carriage Schemes has been considered again by the  
State Government and it has been decided that the stage  
carriage permits issued under Stage Carriage Scheme,*

*2013 and permits of those private operators of 1993 and 2001 Schemes who are eligible for obtaining permits under the Stage Carriage Scheme of 2013 as per para 3 of the notification dated 12.08.2013, may be treated valid as per the terms and conditions of the respective permits and the time table may be issued accordingly.”*

Learned Advocate General, Haryana has submitted that the petitioner would be able to ply their buses as per the terms and conditions of the respective permits held by them and the time table would be issued accordingly.

Director General State Transport, Haryana, Chandigarh who is also present in the Court has stated that the apprehension of the petitioner is totally misplaced as the instructions issued vide order dated 7.05.2015 shall be followed in letter and spirit.

With the assurance given by the Advocate General, Haryana himself in the Court, learned counsel for the petitioner prays for withdrawal of the petition at this stage.

Disposed of accordingly.
