Counsel for the respondents states that the order passed by this Court dated 05.09.2013 (Annexure P-1), contempt of which is alleged to have been committed by the respondents, has been complied with in part as the selection grade has been granted along with arrears. He fairly concedes that the interest on delayed payment has not been released to the petitioner till date. He, on instructions from Sh. Sukhwinder Singh, Superintendent (Legal), states that the interest shall be released to the petitioner within a period of three weeks from today.

In the light of the statement made by the counsel for the respondents, the present contempt petition is disposed of as infructuous with liberty to the petitioner to revive the contempt petition if the time schedule, within which the interest has been undertaken to be released to the petitioner, is not adhered to.
