MAHESH GROVER, J.

Learned counsel for the respondent states that substantial amount of retiral dues have already been released to the petitioner and another sum of Rs. 1.25 lacs has been handed over to the petitioner by way of a draft in Court today. It is further stated that balance amount shall also be disbursed to the petitioner shortly.

Let needful be done in two equated instalments spread out over a period of two months each.

In view of above, instant petition is disposed of with aforesaid directions. In case the respondent fail to comply with these directions he would be burdened with costs of Rs. 20,000/- which shall be recovered from his personal pay. Petitioner would also be at liberty to raise the issue of interest before the respondents.
