TEJINDER SINGH DHINDSA, J. (Oral)

The instant contempt petition was filed alleging non-compliance of interim order dated 28.05.2013 passed by a Division Bench of this Court in CWP No. 13979 of 2012.

Suffice it to observe that challenge in the writ petition was to the orders dated 29.05.2012 and 06.07.2012 passed by the Central Administrative Tribunal, Chandigarh Bench.

Counsel for the parties have apprised this Court that in the meantime, the main writ petition itself i.e. CWP No. 13979 of 2012 has already been decided by the Division Bench vide judgment dated 29.09.2014 and the impugned orders passed by the Central Administrative Tribunal, Chandigarh Bench have been set aside and the matter stands remitted back to the Tribunal for reconsideration on such additional grounds that may be raised against the validity of the retrospective promotion granted to the petitioner. The Division Bench, however, while passing the

order has observed that the promotion of the petitioner as Senior Assistant w.e.f. the year 1990 cannot be undone only on the ground of non-qualifying Assistant Grade Examination.

In the light of such factual position, the instant contempt petition would not survive. The same is accordingly disposed of.
