The Criminal Miscellaneous petition filed by the petitioner was disposed of on 12.5.2014 directing the Superintendent of Police, Ferozepur to look into grievance of the petitioner qua threat to his life and liberty and dispose of the same within 20 days.

It is submitted that the respondent has now passed an order (Annexure P-3) observing that the petitioner does not deserve protection for his life and liberty and for that purpose four reasons have been given.

Unsatisfied with the reasoning of the respondent, the present petition has been filed.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner and after perusal of the record, am of the considered opinion that remedy lies with the petitioner elsewhere instead of filing contempt petition.

In view thereof, learned counsel for the petitioner prays for withdrawal of the petition with liberty to take up his remedy, in accordance with law.

Dismissed as withdrawn.
