The order dated 20.05.2011, the non compliance of which the petitioner alleges, required the respondents to release the amount of incentive/subsidies and other benefits, to the petitioner-industries (if they were otherwise eligible and entitled to it) within a period of six months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the judgment, failing which, thereafter six months, they (petitioner Industries) would also be entitled to interest at the rate of 6% per annum on the accrued benefits till the realization of the amount in this context, which has since been done as has been disclosed in the reply filed by the respondents, rendering the instant petition infructuous, which is disposed of accordingly, leaving the petitioner to his remedies in law in the event of his dissatisfaction against the order so passed.
