The order dated 13.11.2013, non-compliance of which has been alleged by the petitioner required the respondent to hand over the possession of demised premises on or before 30.11.2014 on account of a statement made by him before this Court.

Learned counsel for the respondent on instructions from his client states that the possession was handed over to the petitioner in December, 2014 i.e after one month of the date of assurance.

In view of aforesaid facts, I am of the view that orders of this Court stands complied with, although there was a month's delay in it which is condoned. The rent already stands paid. Hence, instant petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.
