This petition is filed invoking provisions of Sections 10 & 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 for initiating proceedings of contempt against the respondents for willfully and intentionally disobeying the order passed by this Court dated 26.11.2013 in CWP No.25040 of 2012.

From the perusal of record, I have found that the direction was only to decide the legal notice by passing a speaking order. The petitioner himself has attached the said order as Annexure P-1 with this contempt petition.

In view thereof, there is hardly any reason for this Court to proceed against the respondents as the direction issued by this Court has already been duly complied with.

If the speaking order, having been passed by the respondents, is not to the taste of the petitioner then he may take up his remedy, in accordance with law but insofar as the present petition is concerned, it is not maintainable.

Dismissed as such.
