MAHESH GROVER, J.

The order of the writ Court mandated as follows:-

“Consequently, the impugned order dated 14.6.2010

(Annexure P-7) is set aside to the extent of fixing the reserve price at

13,82,371/- for the plot in question and the respondent Board is

directed to recalculate the said price, after adding simple interest at

the rate of 12% per annum on the base reserve price of 1,25,325/- as

was prevalent on 16.3.1993. The CWP no. 23292 of 2011 calculated

amount be intimated to the petitioner firm within a period of two

months from today, which shall be paid by the petitioner firm within

a period of one month thereafter.”

The respondents have looked into the matter and recalculated the

price of the plot in terms of the orders of the writ Court. The only grievance

of the petitioner is that while taking the measurements the plot was taken to be of the size 19.3' x 85' instead of 20' x 85'. The difference in calculation is also attributed to that.

In the considered view of this Court there is sufficient compliance of the orders of the writ Court and therefore, the contempt petition is disposed of. If petitioner has any grievance he is at liberty to approach the respondents in this regard.
