The order dated 10.12.2013, non-compliance of which is alleged by the petitioner mandated the respondents to consider and decide the representation (attached as Annexure P-2 with the writ petition) within a period of three months and to release the dues of the petitioner in case of his entitlement alongwith interest at the rate of 8% per annum.

Reply filed by the State of Punjab indicates compliance.

In view of above, instant petition has been rendered infructuous and the same is disposed of as such, leaving the petitioner to his remedies in law in case of any shortfall.
