Application is allowed. Affidavit of Daljit Singh, Administrator, New Mandi Township, Punjab, Chandigarh is taken on record.

**COCP No.628 of 2015**

The petitioner has initiated contempt proceedings for alleged disobedience of the order passed by this Court dated 13.12.2013.

The respondent has filed reply by way of Misc. Application which has been allowed today in which it is averred that speaking order has already been passed on 15.5.2015 and the matter has been forwarded to the Government for decision in regard to the claim of the petitioner to run Saw Mill in terms of other oustees.

Faced with this circumstance, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he would not pursue this petition any further and has made an

earnest request that a direction may be given to the government to take a decision as early as possible.

Since the government is not arrayed as a party in this contempt petition, therefore, at this stage, it would not be possible for this Court to give any kind of direction to the government. The petitioner, if so advised, may avail other remedy in case the government takes unusual time in taking the decision.
