The order dated 4.12.2014, non-compliance of which is alleged by the petitioner mandated the respondents to look into her grievance regarding fair investigation in the matter pursuant to which a Special Investigating Team was constituted and it was found that the allegations levelled by the petitioner in FIR are wrong.

Learned State counsel on instructions from SHO Jagbir Singh states that cancellation report has been prepared and shall be filed within a period of one week from today.

If that be so then petitioner shall have her remedies in law to oppose the cancellation report submitted before the Court of competent jurisdiction. Hence, instant petition is disposed of in view of the compliance of the orders of the writ Court, leaving the petitioner to her remedies in law.
