The order dated 18.7.2014, non-compliance of which is alleged by the petitioners mandated the respondents to consider and decide the representation (attached as Annexure P-3 with the writ petition) by passing an appropriate order in accordance with law within a period of 3 months from the date of receipt of the certified copy of the order.

Learned counsel for the State submits that needful has been done and a speaking order has been passed, a copy of which has been placed on record.

In view of above, instant petition has been rendered infructuous and the same is disposed of as such, with liberty to the petitioners to challenge the order so passed in case they are dis-satisfied with the same.
