In compliance to the order passed by the Writ Court on 18.07.2013, the respondents have allotted a built up booth on leasehold basis to the petitioner.

The grievance of the petitioner is that certain similarly situated persons were allotted booth at a rate different from the one which was given to the petitioner. This, to the mind of this Court, would be a separate cause to the petitioner to agitate it in separate proceedings.

Contempt petition is, therefore, disposed of being satisfied, leaving the petitioner to her remedies in law in the event of her dissatisfaction against the order so passed.
