The order dated 09.05.2014, the non compliance of which the petitioner alleges, required the respondent no.2 and 3 to consider and decide the legal notice dated 09.09.2013 Annexure P-5 attached with the writ petition within a period of two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order. It was further directed that in case the claim of the petitioner is accepted, the consequential benefits, if any, be released to her, in accordance with law, within a further period of two months and in case the claim of the petitioner is not to be accepted, a well reasoned and speaking order be passed and conveyed to her forthwith, which has since been decided as has been stated at bar by learned counsel for the respondent, rendering the instant petition infructuous, which is disposed of accordingly, leaving the petitioner to his remedies in law in the event of his dissatisfaction against the order so passed.
