AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASIH, J. (Oral):

Affidavit, in compliance with the order dated 10.10.2014 passed by this Court, has been filed in Court, taken on record. On the basis of the affidavit which has been filed in Court today, it has been stated that an amount of ₹48,109/- has been refunded to the petitioner vide cheque No.'374005' dated 22.04.2015 (Annexure R-2/2). He further states that possession has been offered to the petitioner and the petitioner may approach the office of the Estate Officer, Karnal, on 27.04.2015 at 11 AM. He states that on her visiting the said office, Junior Engineer will accompany her to the site and hand over the possession of the shop in question.

Counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner is entitled to the refund of the extension fee which has been charged from the petitioner.

If that be so, let a representation be filed by her within a period

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of 15 days from today which shall be duly considered by Estate Officer, Karnal-respondent No.2 and appropriate orders, as per policy of HUDA, be passed within a period of four weeks from the date of submission of such representation. In case the representation is accepted, the consequential benefits be released to the petitioner within a further period of two weeks.

The contempt petition is disposed of accordingly.
