Mahesh Grover, J

The order, the non compliance of which has been alleged by the petitioner, mandated the Collector to pass an order under Section 7 of the Punjab Village Common Lands (Regulation) Act, 1961 after examining the petitioner's submission and deliver possession to the Gram Panchayat in the eventuality of concluding that the land belongs to it.

The order of the Collector is not on record. Besides, the petitioner has not even cared to implead the Collector as a party respondent as he alleges the violation of the mandate given by this Court on 02.11.2012.

The petition is thus held to be frivolous and is dismissed.
