The petitioners have alleged disobedience of the order passed by this Court on 29.9.2014 in CWP No.20351 of 2014.

Learned counsel for the State has submitted that they were only directed to decide the representation of the petitioners within a period of two months. The decision has now been taken and the representation of the petitioners have been rejected by passing a speaking order dated 30.3.2015.

In view thereof, this petition does not survive but the petitioners may, if so advised, challenge the order dated 30.3.2015, in accordance with law.

Faced with this difficulty, learned counsel for the petitioners prays for withdrawal of the petition with liberty to challenge the order dated 30.3.2015.

Dismissed as withdrawn.
