This order be read in continuation of the order passed by this Court on 03.03.2015 and be treated as its part.

The contemner is present in the Court pursuant to the directions issued. All the details of the fraud and collusion and obstruction in the Course of justice by the contemner have already been noticed in detail in the order dated 03.03.2015. The Court finds that the contemner has obstructed the course of justice to mislead the Court and obtained order on terms which he never intended to honour. He is, therefore, held to be guilty under the Contempt of Court's Act.

Learned counsel appearing on his behalf pleads for leniency and offers the regrets on behalf of the contemner.

After hearing the learned counsel for the contemner, I am of the view that ends of justice would be squarely met if the contemner is burdened with a fine of Rs.50,000/- to be paid to the Haryana State Legal Services Authority and to be deposited with the Court of Chief Judicial Magistrate, Gurgaon within a period of one month from today failing which the said Court would be at liberty to recover the same through coercive process. The Chief Judicial Magistrate, Gurgaon would also be at liberty to apprise this Court in the event of a default and in which situation the contempt proceedings against the contemner would stand revived.
