The order dated 19.01.2015, the non compliance of which the petitioner alleges, required the respondent no.4 of the writ petition to ensure meticulous compliance of the order dated 17.11.2014 which mandated respondent no.4 to pass the appropriate order within two weeks from that day and also mandated respondent-School to file his own affidavit along with the copy of the order passed on or before the next date of hearing, the compliance of which has since been made as has been stated at bar by the learned counsel appearing for the respondents, rendering the instant petition infructuous, which is disposed of accordingly, leaving the petitioner to her remedies in law in the event of her dissatisfaction against the order so passed.
