“Accordingly, the matter has been considered in detail in consultation with the concerned Division and keeping in view of the existing provision of rules/orders/instructions Government of India has accepted in principle “One Rank One Pension” (OROP), however, the modalities for implementation of OROP are under consideration of the Government of India. Further, as regards recovery of loan from pension by the bank, the issue does not pertain to Ministry of Defence and cannot be commented.”

In view of the stand taken by the respondents that the Government of India has already taken decision with regard to OROP, which is yet to be implemented, the order passed by this
