Despite the fact that re-calculations were given on 20.1.2014 in terms of the earlier orders of this Court dated 8.11.2013, the petitioner has not cared to file any counter or apprise the respondents of any discrepancies therein. Matter has been pending for more than 1 ½ years for this purpose, resulting in sheer wastage of the time of the Court. The instant petition is thus, disposed of with a direction to the petitioner to approach the respondents in case of any discrepancy regarding re-calculations. He may do so within a period of four weeks from today upon which the respondents shall be under an obligation to satisfy the grievance of the petitioner in case there is any.
