On 26.5.2010, the writ petition filed by the petitioners was disposed of with a direction to the respondents to decide their representation within eight weeks.

Learned counsel for the respondents has submitted that the said representation has already been decided on 27.7.2010. Learned counsel for the petitioners, however, submits that the decision in the writ petition is not in accordance with law.

Since the basic order passed by this Court has been complied with, therefore, this petition has become infructuous but the petitioners definitely have a right to challenge the order dated 27.7.2010 in accordance with law, if so advised.

Dismissed as infructuous.
