Costs as ordered by this Court stands sent to the petitioner through registered post as has been mentioned in para 5 of the affidavit, which has been filed today and taken on record. As per the said affidavit, the amount due to the petitioner has been credited in her account.

This renders the present contempt petition infructuous.

Disposed of with directions to Principal, Government Girls College, Patiala-respondent No.3 that the break up and calculations will be given by her to the petitioner within a period of four weeks. On receipt of said break up and calculations, in case the same is not to the satisfaction of the petitioner, the petitioner may file a detailed representation to Director Public Instructions (Colleges), PSEB New Building Complex, Sector 62, Phase VIII, SAS Nagar, Mohali-respondent No.2, who shall consider and take a decision thereon within a period of six weeks of submission of such representation.

In case the claim of the petitioner is accepted, the consequential

benefits, if any, be handed over to the petitioner, in accordance with law, within a further period of four weeks. In case the claim of the petitioner is not to be accepted, a well reasoned and speaking order be passed and conveyed to the petitioner forthwith.
