AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASIH, J. (Oral):

An additional affidavit has been filed on behalf of General Manager, Haryana Roadway, Bhiwani, according to which, the benefit which the petitioner is entitled to has been released. As regards the arrears of over-time allowance is concerned, it has been stated that the petitioner is not entitled to the said benefit in the light of the Haryana Government instructions dated 03.02.2010 (Annexure R-3).

In view of the above, the present contempt petition is disposed of as infructuous with liberty to the petitioner, if so advised, to avail of his remedy, in accordance with law, against the denial of the arrears of over-time allowance.
