On 7.3.2014, while issuing notice of motion, the respondent was burdened with cost of ₹25,000/- which was ordered to be recovered from his personal pay. However, it was also observed that the order regarding cost would be amenable for recalling in case some justification is shown. There is no dispute that the order passed by this Court has been duly complied with and the respondent has filed *CM No.15672-CII-2014* for recalling of the order dated 7.3.2014.

Notice in the application.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has accepted the notice and raised no objection for recalling of the order dated 7.3.2014. Accordingly, the application is allowed and the order regarding imposition of costs of ₹25,000/- is hereby recalled.

Since, the order passed by this Court has been duly complied with, therefore, present contempt petition has become infructuous.

Dismissed as infructuous.

However, the petitioner may, if so advised, pursue his other remedies, in accordance with law, for claiming of pension.
