The order dated 23.9.2013, non-compliance of which is alleged by the petitioner mandated the respondents to consider and decide the legal notice (attached as Annexure P-2 with the writ petition) by passing a speaking order within a period of 2 months from the date of receipt of the certified copy of the order.

Reply indicates that needful has since been done and a speaking order passed.

At this stage, learned counsel for the respondents states that payments have also been released to the petitioner and only 3rd instalment remains which shall also be released as per seniority.

In view of above, when orders of the writ Court stands complied with, instant petition has been rendered infructuous and the same is disposed of as such, with liberty to the petitioner to avail himself of his remedies in law in the event of any shortfalls. Rule against the respondents is discharged.
