Short affidavit of Sh. Harbans Singh Bhatti, General Manager, Pepsu Road Transport Corporation, Chandigarh Depot. has been filed. In para 3 thereof, the details of retiral benefits that have already been paid to the petitioner, have been mentioned. Insofar as the payment of third installment (amounting to Rs.44,930/-) of pay/pension revision arrear is concerned, it is stated that the same would be paid by the respondent-Corporation as per seniority.

In view of the above, COCP is disposed of as infructuous.

Learned counsel for petitioner states that the petitioner is also entitled to interest for delayed payment of retiral benefits. For this, he may represent to the respondents, who would consider it in accordance with law.
