Mahesh Grover, J

The Writ Court had directed the reimbursement of amount along with interest @ 9% per annum within a period of two months which has since been done and not disputed by the petitioner. He, however, questions the issuance of a charge sheet against him.

Respondents have stated that they derive strength from the order of the Writ Court which granted them liberty to proceed against the petitioner by conducting an inquiry in accordance with law.

If that be so then the respondents cannot be proceeded for contempt as they have placed an interpretation on the order of the Court which has granted them liberty to proceed against the petitioner.

The petition is disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to impugn the action of the respondents in the event of his dissatisfaction and if permissible in law.
