This petition is filed for the disobedience of the order dated 1.8.2014 by which Crl. Misc. No.M-25858 of 2014 filed by the petitioner was disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3/Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana, to look into the matter and decide the representation (Annexure P-5), attached with the petition, within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order. The respondent has informed the petitioner's counsel through letter dated 31.1.2015, who had served upon a contempt notice for disobedience of the order dated 1.8.2014, that the investigation has been carried out by the Additional Commissioner of Police, Gill, Ludhiana, who has mentioned in his report that one FIR No.62 dated 9.7.2013 under Sections 447/511/506/427/379/148/149 of the IPC was registered in the

Police Station Habowal, Ludhiana against Ramanpreet Singh son of Gurdarshan Singh son of Tirath Singh resident of 11-SF, Rishi Nagar, Ludhiana and others. The said matter was investigated and untraced report under Section 173 of the Cr.P.C. was prepared thus, it is submitted that the order passed by this Court has been duly complied with.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has disputed the information supplied by the respondent and has argued that the complaint made by the petitioner was altogether different as it was pertaining to forgery.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner and after going through the available record, am of the considered opinion that the respondent has passed the order, which is not to the liking of the petitioner, who may, if so advised, challenge that order in accordance with law.

Dismissed as withdrawn.
