Learned counsel appearing for respondent No.1 would make a statement at the bar that in pursuance to the order dated 08.07.2013 passed by this Court, whereby 12 connected revision petitions i.e. ***Civil Revision No.7584 of 2012 (Municipal Council, Fatehabad Vs. Pankaj and other connected petitions)*** were disposed of, a speaking order dated 31.12.2013 has been passed. A copy of the order has been furnished to the counsel for the petitioner.

In the light of such factual position, this Court is satisfied that there has been substantial compliance of the directions issued by this Court on 08.07.2013.

Resultantly, the contempt petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.

Rule discharged.
