Learned counsel for the petitioner, *inter alia*, contends that the matter was compromised before the Mediation Centre of this Court and on the basis thereof, an order was passed on 16.1.2015. At that time, liberty was given to the respondent/husband to move an application for revival of the appeal in case compromise dated 18.11.2014 is not acted upon by the petitioner/wife herein. It is submitted that the respondent/husband, who sought the liberty from the Division Bench, himself has backed out from the compromise, therefore, the contempt petition has been filed.

Be that as it may, the liberty, which has been given to the respondent/husband in the order dated 16.1.2015 also enures to the benefit of the petitioner, who may file an application for revival of the petition as it is averred and alleged that the respondent has backed out from the compromise.

Learned counsel for the petitioner prays for withdrawal of the petition in order to file an application for revival of the petition.

Dismissed as withdrawn.
