Instructions (Primary Education) Punjab on behalf of respondent no.1 has been filed in the Court today and the same is taken on record. A copy thereof has been supplied to the counsel opposite.

The order dated 12.12.2014, non-compliance of which is alleged by the petitioners mandated the respondents to consider and decide the representation (attached as Annexure P-5 with the writ petition) made by the petitioners by passing a speaking order in accordance with law within a period of 3 months from the date of receipt of the certified copy of the order.
