AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASIH, J. (Oral):

Counsel for the respondents, on instructions from Ms. Gurpreet Kaur, Assistant Director, O/o DPI (School Education), Punjab, states that respondent No.2 has retired and she, being the senior most in the office, has put in appearance. She states that costs as imposed by this Court shall be deposited today itself. Her further submission is that vide order dated 08.08.2014, the Competent Authority i.e. District Education Officer (Elementary Education), Mansa, has passed a detailed speaking order. Counsel, thus, contends that the present contempt petition has been rendered infructuous.

Counsel for the petitioners states that liberty may be granted to the petitioners to challenge the order dated 08.08.2014.
