Additional affidavit of R.S.Kharb, Director, Elementary Education

Haryana, Panchkula has been filed in the Court today and the same is taken on record.

A copy thereof has been supplied to the counsel opposite.

The aforesaid affidavit indicates that process of release of the retiral dues of the petitioner is at an advanced stage. The Manager of the Allahabad Bank, New Delhi has been instructed to release the payment to the petitioner w.e.f November, 2015. An amount of Rs. 11,54,977/- is likely to be deposited in the account of the petitioner shortly. A demand draft of Rs.50,000/- has also been paid to the learned counsel for the petitioner on account of costs imposed by this Court.

In view of above, when orders of the writ Court stands complied with, instant petition has been rendered infructuous and the same is disposed of as such, with liberty to the petitioner to take recourse to his remedies in law in the event of any shortfalls. Rule against the respondents is discharged.
