The order dated 10.7.2013, non-compliance of which is alleged by the petitioners mandated the respondents to consider and decide the legal notice (attached as Annexure P-7 with the writ petition) by passing a speaking order within a period of 3 months from the date of receipt of the certified copy of the order.

It has been stated by the learned counsel for the petitioners that the same has been done and principal amount has been paid to the petitioners but no interest has been paid.

In view of above, instant petition has been rendered infructuous and the same is disposed of as such, with liberty to the petitioners to avail themselves of their remedies in law for seeking payment of interest component.
