Learned counsel for the parties are *ad idem* that the order dated 30.1.2013, passed by this Court in CWP No.1972 of 2013 has since been complied with inasmuch as the encroachments from the land in question have already been removed.

Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner would, however, submit that even though, the encroachments have since been demolished but the debris is yet to be removed.

Learned counsel for the respondent furnishes an assurance to this Court that even such action as regards removal of debris of the demolished encroachments would be undertaken expeditiously and in any case within a period of four weeks from today.

Accordingly, the instant contempt petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.
