AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASIH, J. (ORAL)

Counsel for the petitioner states that the orders passed by this Court have been complied with. However, the petitioner is disputing the calculations, which have been made by the respondents. He, thus, prays for liberty to file a representation, highlighting the discrepancies in the calculations, if any, within four weeks to the Superintending Engineer, Operation Circle, Haryana Bijli Vitran Nigam Limited, Kaithal, which may be ordered to be considered and decided within some specified time.

In the light of the statement made by counsel for the petitioner, the present petition is disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to file a representation, if any, within a period of four weeks to the Superintending

Engineer, Operation Circle, Haryana Bijli Vitran Nigam Limited, Kaithal. If such a representation is filed within the time stipulated, the same shall be considered and decided by passing a speaking order within a period of six weeks from the date of submission of representation. Decision so taken be conveyed to the petitioner forthwith.

In case the claim of the petitioner is accepted, the consequential benefits be released to him within a further period of four weeks.
