The judgment debtor is in revision aggrieved by the orders dated 16.07.2014 (**P-1**) and 26.11.2014 (**P-2**), passed by learned Addl. Civil Judge (Sr. Divn.), Patti, whereby his objections to the decree for recovery on the basis of pronote and receipt were dismissed and sale warrants were issued.

During the course of hearing, learned Counsel for the petitioner states that the present revision has become infructuous in the light of a compromise having been arrived at between the parties.
