The order dated 31.5.2013, non-compliance of which is alleged by the petitioner mandated the respondents to consider and decide her claim for grant of ex-gratia compensation within a period of 4 months and in case of her entitlement, the same shall be given to her within a period of 15 days thereafter.

Learned counsel for respondent no.3 states that needful has been done and a speaking order rejecting the claim of the petitioner has been passed. He has also placed on record a copy of the said order.

In view of above, instant petition has been rendered infructuous and the same is disposed of as such, with liberty to the petitioner to challenge the order so passed in case she is dis-satisfied with the same.
