The petitioner-defendant has impugned the order dated 15.1.2015 only to a limited extent whereby the appeal of the petitioner-defendant has been allowed and ex-parte judgment and decree dated 22.3.2014 has been set aside with the condition that the petitioner-defendant shall pay entire arrears of rent within a period of one month from the date of passing of the order i.e. upto 14.2.2015.

Mr. Lokesh Sinhal, learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner-defendant has apprised the court that since the petitioner-defendant had impugned the order and was hopeful of succeeding in the present revision petition and therefore did not deposit the arrears as ordered by the appellate court but in the

meantime the warrant of possession has been issued on 19.2.2015. He fairly concedes that in case two weeks' time is granted to comply with the order dated 15.1.2015 the petitioner will pay the entire arrears of rent.

The prayer made by the learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner-defendant is fair and justified and it is thus directed that in case the petitioner-defendant deposits the entire arrears of rent within a period of two weeks from today, the warrant of possession stated to be issued on 19.2.2015 shall be kept in abeyance and in case the petitioner-defendant do not comply with the direction or undertaking, the trial court shall be at liberty to proceed with the execution proceedings.

It is further directed that in case the petitioner-defendant deposits the amount then the proceedings in the suit will commence as per the directions contained in the order dated 15.1.2015.

The civil revision is disposed of with the above directions.
