AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASI, J. (Oral):

Counsel for the respondents has produced the orders dated 19.05.2015 passed by the State Project Director, HSSPP, Panchkula, rejecting the claims of petitioners 1 and 2. He states that the present contempt petition has been rendered infructuous as the other petitioners have been given appointment letters.

Counsel for the petitioners informs the Court that these two petitioners had filed CWP No.11883 of 2015, titled as 'Balram and another Vs. State of Haryana & another' which has been allowed by this Court vide order dated 29.05.2015 setting aside the orders dated 19.05.2015 in same terms as in CWP No.7626 of 2015, titled as 'Gurmail Kaur and ors. Vs. State of Haryana & anr'. He states that after passing of the said order, petitioners have submitted their representations to the respondent which till date have not been

The State Project Director, HSSPP, Panchkula, respondent herein, is directed to decide the representations of the petitioners within a period of four weeks from today and thereafter take appropriate steps in accordance with law to give appointment letters unless there is an order of the Competent Court otherwise.
