Counsel for the respondents states that the petitioner has been granted the benefit of crossing of the efficiency bar vide order dated 31.07.2015 and has further been granted the benefit of DCRG and leave encashment and the amount due has been released to the petitioner. As regards the other retiral benefits, because of the revision in the pension, the same shall be re-fixed and the orders released to the petitioner within a period of six weeks from today.
