At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that present eviction petition under Section 13 of the Haryana Urban (Control of Rent and Eviction) Act has been filed by the respondent-landlord for ejectment of the petitioner-tenant and the main issue with regard to the execution of the agreement arises in the civil suit No. 719/13, dated 19.04.2012 for which CR No. 961 of 2015 has been filed. It is further contended that respondent has not produced expert witness whereas the petitioner has produced his complete evidence. Therefore, learned counsel for petitioner withdraws the instant petition as the complete evidence has been led.
