The writ petition of the petitioners was disposed of on 7.10.2013 directing the respondent to decide their representation within a period of two months by passing a speaking order.

Reply is filed today in Court and a copy thereof is given to counsel for the petitioners.

It is averred in para No.6 of the reply that the representation was decided vide order No.112 dated 2.12.2013. The arrears on account of difference of subsistence allowance for the period 1.12.2013 to 28.2.2014 has been paid to the suspended employees. The amount by way of cheque dated 26.3.2014 vide letter dated 16.4.2014 was sent through speed post and thereafter subsistence allowance of 75% is being paid to them.

In view of the stand taken by the respondent in para No.6 of the reply, the present petition has become infructuous. However, in case the petitioners have still some grievance left on account of non-payment of amount, they may file an application for its revival.
