CA No.216 of 2014

Mr. D.K. Singal, Advocate for the petitioner submits that in view of the order of admitting the petition, this Court had deferred the

publication for a period of four months in order to enable the respondent-company to settle the outstanding dues. However, no such effort has been made. After awaiting four months, the petitioner has advertised the admitting order in the newspapers & the Official Gazette of Government of Punjab. Affidavit of publication filed by the Advocate is taken on record.

Since this Court had already passed detailed order while admitting the petition, I need not to repeat the same.

In view of the fact, the respondent-company had failed to discharge the admitted liability, I deem it appropriate to wound up the company petition.

Ordered accordingly.

Official Liquidator attached to this Court is appointed as Liquidator of the respondent company and he is directed to take over the charge of moveable and immoveable assets and record of respondent company.

Let the publication order of winding up be published in the newspapers namely "The Indian Express" (English) and "Punjabi Tribune" and the official Gazette of the Government of Punjab.

Petition is disposed of accordingly.

CA No.422 of 2014

In view of order passed in CP No.76 of 2012, no order is required to be passed in the present application, as the same has become infructuous and disposed of accordingly.
