RAKESH KUMAR JAIN, J.

The petitioner is aggrieved against the order dated 22.9.2014, allowing an application for *ad interim* maintenance, filed by the respondents by which his wife has been awarded maintenance of ₹1500/- per month and the daughter has been awarded ₹1000/- per month.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has vehemently argued that the Courts below have erred in awarding the *ad interim* maintenance though the respondents are not the indigent persons. It is also submitted that respondent No.1 had sold 1 biswa and 10 biswasi of land and she is not the legally wedded wife of the petitioner.

The learned Court below has observed in the concluding paragraph of the impugned order that the marriage has been

admitted by both the parties and it is the moral duty of the petitioner/husband to maintain his wife and minor child. In this regard, the Court below has awarded *ad interim* maintenance of ₹1500/- per month to the wife and ₹1000/- per month to minor daughter.

In view thereof, I do not find any merit in the present revision petition and the same is hereby dismissed.
