Counsel, at the outset, submits that the dispute is squarely covered against him in view of the orders passed by this Court in CR No.6314 of 2014, which has been dismissed by passing a detailed order on 10.11.2014. He, however, submits that since the petitioner is an aged person and running a tea stall, he may be granted 3 months time to vacate the land in question.

Keeping in view the just prayer made, this Court is of the opinion that since the dispute is pertaining to an area of 7"x5", under a tin shed and the Lower Appellate Court had granted the said relief to the respondents and initially, the petitioner had been successful, he is entitled for this much indulgence.

Accordingly, the present revision petition is disposed of with a direction to the Executing Court not to dispossess the petitioner before 20.04.2015.

However, the petitioner shall file an affidavit before the Executing Court that he shall vacate and hand-over the possession of the said area by 20.04.2015.
